



Lowcountry Master Gardener Association Job Description - Member-At Large

A Member of the Board of the Lowcountry Master Gardener Association (LMGA) with the designation of "at large" has no specific duties unless assigned by the President of the Board or a Board Committee but has the same rights and responsibilities as other Board members. The Member at Large is a member of the Board team responsible for directing and managing the overall operations of the Association.

Responsibilities

- Must be a certified active South Carolina Master Gardener and a member in good standing with LMGA.
- Serve as an ambassador of LMGA mission, programs, and services.
- Prepare for and arrives on time for all meetings
- Initially agree to a two-year Board term.
- Regularly attend and prepare for LMGA Board meetings and important related meetings.
- Commit to professional development to maintain active Master Gardener status.
- Volunteer for and willingly accept assignments and complete them thoroughly and on time.

- Serve on committees as assigned by the President of the LMGA Board.
- Be knowledgeable about LMGA's mission, vision, programs, and events.
- Stays informed about Board matters, prepare for meetings, review and comment on issues of importance.
- Get to know other LMGA Board members and establish a relationship that contributes to the mission of LMGA.
- Respond to requests for feedback or decisions between meetings in a timely manner.
- Participate in any other way that is helpful to the advancement of LMGA.
